Island Star Accommodation

- Sleeps 4 adults and 4 children
- Bedroom 1- 1x Queen size bed (electric blanket) + **en-suite bathroom**
- Bedroom 2- 1x Double bed (electric blanket)
- Bedroom 3- 2 bunk beds (sleeps 4)
- All bedrooms have robes/hanging space
- Main Bathroom + Main WC + Laundry

The open-plan tiled living-dining room is expansive and is surrounded by ceiling- to -floor windows and sliding doors maximizing the sea views.

Keys and Access

At the entrance of the stairs you will find a wall mounted wooden key safe unit.

Inside the unit there are 2 keys safes. Instructions are on the inside of the key safe unit door.

One safe holds the keys for the main house and other for the garage keys.

Once you have the keys, walk up the stairs to the main house and use the MIDDLE set of sliding doors for access.

A door mat is placed at the entrance of these sliding doors. Please remember to lock these doors as well when vacating the beach house.

Once inside you will find a comprehensive Guest Information Book filled with details about how the house works, quirks and services.

Before you get to the beach house

When you get to the Cape Jervis Sealink Ferry terminal there's a wall of brochures and information about what to do on KI – very useful. Take the KI Information brochure too – has a map of the island

When you land at Penneshaw go the local supermarket (**IGA**), and do your grocery shopping for your essentials before you drive to the beach house. That way you don't have to double back again. Ask a local and they will show you, its 1 minute from the ferry landing. **Buy plenty of drinking water.**

Remember to bring along...

All food requirements; top loader washing machine powder (*if using the washing machine*); garbage bags (large); toilet paper (*provided for first 2 days*); paper napkins; all personal hygiene effects; sunscreens and hats; first aid kit; torch (*especially important if you are arriving at night*); **and Beach towels.**

We will provide all the bathroom towels. Straw beach mats are provided.

Water

The entire house is supplied with rainwater. With this in mind we ask that you use the water in a sensible manner. Boil for drinking or bring your own bottled or cask water.

If the water level or water pressure seems low, please call Angie on 0413 753 198.

Outdoor Umbrella

Please be aware that winds on Kangaroo Island can be quite strong so we ask that the outdoor umbrella is closed during windy periods to avoid damage or accidents.

BBQ

Please clean the BBQ and place the cover back for the enjoyment of the next guests.

On Leaving

We ask that you vacate the beach house by **10.00am on your day** of departure so that the caretaker may prepare the beach house for the next guests.

We also ask that house be left in a neat and tidy manner. Some cleaning products are found under the kitchen sink for your use.

Please strip the used bed linen and pillow cases and leave them in the laundry.

PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE THE QUILT COVERS (unless they are soiled).

Please ensure that both the BBQ hotplate and outdoor table are cleaned.

Please check all sliding doors are locked and return the keys to the 'Key Safe'

Local Information

IGA supermarket in Penneshaw is open 7 days.

At Island Beach you can buy bread, milk, daily newspapers, incidentals, BBQ gas and fuel at Carey's Store. To get there from Island Star beach house go to the end of Penguin Street, turn right onto Island Beach Road and it is about 1.5km on the left. Check opening times at the store.

BBQ Gas bottles can be exchanged at Carey's Store on Island Beach Rd. Please ask the store to note the amount on our account and we will finalise this directly with Carey's Store.

If Carey's Store is closed the closest store is in Penneshaw. Please keep the receipt for reimbursement. We will reimburse you at the end of your stay.
